Variation 3

Measures 1-4 of Variation 3. The piece begins with a piano introduction marked *f*. The right hand features triplet patterns, while the left hand provides a rhythmic accompaniment.

Measures 5-8 of Variation 3. The piano introduction continues with triplet patterns in the right hand and a strong accompaniment in the left hand, marked *f*.

ritenuto
